Terry Simms spoke about the minimum efficiency for 2006. He said that on January 23, 2006, the minimum will jump to 13 SEER, a 30% increase over the current standard. He also mentioned that the 13 SEER minimum requirements will apply to everyone including consumers, local HVAC dealers and all manufactures of air conditioners and heat pumps. It will only apply to new equipment manufactured on or after January 23, 2006. Mr. Simms also spoke about Aero seal. This is a certified duct diagnostic and sealing technology by Carrier. Aero seal is a self-sealing

vinyl polymer aerosol particles and it will fill gaps as wide as 3/8" inches even in hard to reach trouble spots.
